- 2. Greek: Diabolos (37X)
 - Devil, slanderer, deceiver (Matt 4:1; 25:41; John 13:2; Acts 13:10; 1 Tim 3:11; 2 Tim 3:3; Titus 2:3; Heb 2:14; Jas 24:7)

- 3. Evil one
 - Intrinsically evil (John 17:15)
- 4. Great red dragon
 - Destructive powers (Rev 12:3, 7, 9)
- 5. Serpent
 - Deceiver (Gen 3; Rev 12:9)
- 6. Abaddon
 - Destruction (Rev 9:11)

Satan: The Biblical Terms

- 7. Apollyon
 - Destroyer (Rev 9:11)
- 8. Adversary
 - Opposer (1 Pet 5:8)
- 9. Beelzebub
 - Ruler of demons; lit. "Lord of the fly" (Matt 12:24)
- 10.Belial
 - Worthless (2 Cor 6:15)

Satan: The Biblical Terms

- 11. God of this world
 - Influences world's philosophy (2 Cor 4:4)
- 12. Ruler of this world
 - Rules current world system (John 12:31)
- 13. Prince of the power of the air
 - Control of unbelievers (Eph 2:2)
- 14. Enemy
 - Opponent (Matt 13:28)

Satan: The Biblical Terms

15. Tempter

• Tempts people to sin (Matt 4:3; Cf. Jas 1:13-15)

16. Murderer

• Seeks to kill (John 8:44; Cf. 10:10)

17. Liar

• Perverts the truth (John 8:44)

18. Accuser

• Opposes believers before God (Rev 12:10)

Satan's Nature

1. His creation

- John 1:3; Col 1:16-17; Ezek 28:13
- Present in Eden

Satan's Nature

2. His personality

- Intellect (2 Cor 11:3; Eph 6:11; Rev 12:9; Matt 4:5-6)
- Emotion (Luke 22:31; 1 Tim 3:6; Rev 12:12)
- Will (Matt 4:3 2 Tim 2:26)
- He is held morally responsible for his actions (Matt 25:41)
- He is referred to with pronouns (Job 1; Matt 4)

Satan's Nature

3. His original state

- Ezek 28:12-15
 - Exalted position in heaven
 - · Anointed cherub
 - Perfect in beauty; dazzling coverings
 - Full of wisdom
 - Perfect in his ways
 - · Created by God

Satan's Nature

4. His fall

- Because of sin, he was cast from heaven (Ezek 28:16).
- The reason for his downfall was pride (Ezek 28:17).
- His wisdom became corrupt (Ezek 28:17).

Satan's Nature

5. His judgment

- Ultimate judgment announced (Gen 3:15)
- Judgment accomplished (Heb 2:14)
- No more access to heaven (Rev 12:8)
- Bottomless pit for 1,000 years (Rev 20:2-3)
- Final judgment in Lake of Fire (Rev 20:7-10)

Satan's Deception

- 1. His names indicate his very deceptive nature.
- 2. In relation to Christ...
 - Herod's plot (Matt 2:16)
 - Jesus' temptation (Matt 4:1-11)
 - Gog and Magog (Rev 20:7-10)

Satan's Deception

- 3. In relation to God...
 - Temptation in Garden (Gen 3)
 - Increasing worldwide deception (2 Tim 3:13; 2 Thess 2:9-11; Matt 24-25)
- 4. In relation to unbelievers...
 - Blind them in unbelief (2 Cor 4:4)
 - Hides the Gospel (Luke 8:12)
 - Counterfeit religion and faulty worldview (Col 1:13; 2:6-10; 1 John 2:15-17)

Satan's Deception

- 5. In relation to believers...
 - Tempts (1 Thess 3:5; 1 Cor 7:5)
 - Accuses (Rev 12:10)
 - Opposes/attacks/kills (1 Pet 5:8; John 8:44)

The Height of Deception

2 Thessalonians 2:1-12

Five Keys to Overcoming Deception

- 1. Do not fear. (vv. 1-3)
- 2. Keep walking in the truth. (vv. 6-7)
- 3. Always remember we win in the end! (v. 8)
- 4. Be on guard: Things will get worse. (vv. 9-10)
- 5. Don't wait! (vv. 11-12)
