A. You	u need to KNOW the truth well enough in order to IDENTIFY error (2:14-16)
	As believers we should argue with each other or unbelievers about things that will ultimately benefit them or us in the long run. (2 Tim. 2:14; 1 Tim. 1:3-4)

	A necessary guard against false teaching is to zealously persist in personally, interpreting, and God's Word for spiritual nourishment. (2:15)

	This to false doctrine is not reserved for unbelievers or immature believers, but even pastors and teachers are to be on guard of its nature. (2 Tim. 2:16; Titus 3:9)
