### **I. CAN YOU REALLY KNOW THE LORD GOD?**

#### **A. God is KNOWABLE**

1. In Genesis 1:1 the Bible begins by assuming the \_\_\_\_\_ of God.

### **II. HOW CAN GOD REALLY BE KNOWN BY US?**

#### **A. God’s GENERAL Revelation of Himself to Man**

1. Special revelation occurred in the past when God revealed Himself through...
  - a. Audible speech (Gen. 2:15-17; 3:9-19; 12:1-3)
  - b. Theophanies (Gen. 16:7-14; Ex. 3:2)
  - c. Angelic messengers (Dan. 9:20-22; Luke 2:10-11)
  - d. Visible miracles (Mic. 6:5; Ezek. 25:7)
  - e. Casting lots (Prov. 16:33; Acts 1:21-26)
  - f. Urim and Thummim (Ex. 28:30; Num. 27:21)
  - g. Dreams (Gen. 41; Dan. 2)
  - h. Visions (Isa. 1:1; 6:1; Ezek. 1:3)
  
2. God has revealed Himself in human form in the Person of \_\_\_\_\_.  
(John 1:1, 14, 18; Heb. 1:2-3)
  
3. God has revealed Himself in written form through the \_\_\_\_\_.  
(2 Tim. 3:13-17)

## **C. Man's Responsibility to Have an INDIVIDUAL RESPONSE to God**
