V. WHAT ARE GOD'S ATTRIBUTES?

- A. God is SOVEREIGN
- B. God is HOLY
 - 1. The meaning of God's holiness is that He is SEPARATE or SET APART from everything in His creation; He is moral PURITY or PERFECTION from all sin and evil.
 - 2. Holiness is true of all three Members of the Trinity.
 - 3. In the OT, wherever God dwells becomes "holy ground" (Ex. 3:5); consequently, the Bible describes God's holy THRONE, HILL, HEAVEN, TEMPLE, MOUNTAIN, or the NEW JERUSALEM.
 - 4. The Scriptures also attach God's holiness to His NAME, ANGELS, PROPHETS, and LAW.
 - 5. The importance of God's holiness is underscored as FOUNDATIONAL to His other attributes. (Ps. 47:8; 89:14; 97:2)
 - 6. Two attributes of God that stem from His holiness are His RIGHTEOUSNESS and JUSTICE.
