

## Spiritual Gifts in the Church Age Pt. 1

### I. SPIRITUAL GIFTS

#### A. A spiritual gift DEFINED

1. A spiritual gift is a special ability from God given by the sovereignty of the Holy Spirit for \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ to the Lord and \_\_\_\_\_. (Rom. 12:4-8; 1 Cor. 12:7-10, 27-28; 14:6; Eph. 4:11-12)
2. The word translated as “*gift*” is the Greek word “*charisma*”, meaning a gift that was given on the basis of \_\_\_\_\_ and not \_\_\_\_\_. (Eph. 4:7-8)
3. Every believer in Christ receives at \_\_\_\_\_ gift at the time of salvation. (I Pet. 4:10)

#### B. Spiritual GIFTS and the LOCAL CHURCH

### II. SPIRITUAL GIFTS AS TAUGHT IN 1 CORINTHIANS 12

#### A. Spiritual Gifts: their DIVERSITY and their PURPOSE (1 Cor. 12:1-11)

1. “*There are diversities of gifts...*” calls attention to the \_\_\_\_\_ of gifts, although all of them are \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ by the same Spirit. (12:4)

### III. THE 10 TEMPORARY SPIRITUAL GIFTS

#### A. Duration of time: from the Day of Pentecost until the New Testament Canon was complete.

1. **Word of Wisdom** — a \_\_\_\_\_ gift assisting in the \_\_\_\_\_ of doctrine to the church. (1Cor. 12:8)
2. **Word of Knowledge** — a \_\_\_\_\_ gift assisting in the knowledge and \_\_\_\_\_ of God’s will (1Cor. 12:8) prior to the written revelation for the church.
3. **Faith** — a gift used to \_\_\_\_\_ such as those recorded in Acts 3:6-11; 5:14-16; 13:9-11.
4. **Healing** — the ability to instantaneously, \_\_\_\_\_ another person. (1Cor. 12:9, 30).
5. **Miracles** — the power of individuals to instantaneously change the \_\_\_\_\_. (Acts 6:8; 1Cor. 12:10, 28-29; Gal. 3:5)
6. **Prophecy** — a gift involving two divine abilities (1) \_\_\_\_\_ telling future things and (2) \_\_\_\_\_ telling God’s revelation. (Rom. 12:6; Eph. 2:20, 3:5, 4:11; 1Cor. 13:8-11, 14:24, 31, 39)
7. **Discerning of spirits** — the ability to \_\_\_\_\_ false teaching and even the spirit behind such teaching. (1Cor. 12:10; 1 John 4:1)
8. **Tongues** — the ability to communicate the Word of God and the Gospel in a \_\_\_\_\_ foreign language \_\_\_\_\_ studying the language. (Acts 2:1-21)
9. **Interpretation of tongues** — the \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ the foreign language spoken by the person possessing the gift of tongues. (1Cor. 12:10, 14:26-28)
10. **Apostles** — a limited gift of \_\_\_\_\_ over doctrine and practice in the early Church of the first century.
