	2.	Evangelist — a special gift of in a skilled way so that the lost trust in Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. (Eph. 4:11-16; 1Tim. 5:17-20; Tit. 1:5; James 5:14-15; 1Pet. 5:1-4)
	3.	Teachers — the ability to the Scriptures, Biblical principles and believers in the application of truth in their lives. (Rom. 12:6-7; 1 Cor. 12:28-29; Acts 13:1)
	4.	Exhortation — the gifted ability to, and fellow believers in the character and Word of God. (Rom. 12:8)
	5.	Administrations — a gift to steer, or in the local church. (1Cor. 12:28)
	6.	Ruling —a gift to the church in, priorities and doctrine. (1Thess. 5:12-13; 1Tim. 3:4-5, 12)
	7.	Ministry — a gift to other believers in need. (Rom. 12:7; 1Cor. 12:28)
	8.	Helps — a gift to the many of other people in the local church and then the desire to meet those (1Cor. 12:28)
	9.	Giving — a gift to give material or for the Lord's glory and others benefit. (Rom. 12:8)
	10.	Mercy — a gift to extend great, forbearance and, to others in their trials and suffering. (Rom. 12: 8)
