

## Spiritual Gifts in the Church Age Pt. 2

### I. SPIRITUAL GIFTS

#### A. A spiritual gift DEFINED

1. A spiritual gift is a special ability from God given by the sovereignty of the Holy Spirit for \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ to the Lord and \_\_\_\_\_. (Rom. 12:4-8; 1 Cor. 12:7-10, 27-28; 14:6; Eph. 4:11-12)
2. The word translated as “*gift*” is the Greek word “*charisma*”, meaning a gift that was given on the basis of \_\_\_\_\_ and not \_\_\_\_\_. (Eph. 4:7-8)
3. Every believer in Christ receives at \_\_\_\_\_ gift at the time of salvation. (I Pet. 4:10)

#### B. Spiritual GIFTS and the LOCAL CHURCH

#### A. Spiritual Gifts: their DIVERSITY and their PURPOSE (1 Cor. 12:1-11)

1. “*There are diversities of gifts...*” calls attention to the \_\_\_\_\_ of gifts, although all of them are \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ by the same Spirit. (12:4)

A. Duration of time: from the Day of Pentecost until the New Testament Canon was complete.

### IV. THE 10 PERMANENT SPIRITUAL GIFTS

A. Duration of time: from the Day of Pentecost until the Rapture of the Church.

1. **Pastor-teacher** — a gift for \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ the local church with guiding authority and to feed them the Word of God. (Eph. 4:11-16; 1Tim. 5:17-20; Tit. 1:5; James 5:14-15; 1Pet. 5:1-4)
2. **Evangelist** — a special gift of \_\_\_\_\_ in a skilled way so that the lost trust in Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. (Eph. 4:11-16; 1Tim. 5:17-20; Tit. 1:5; James 5:14-15; 1Pet. 5:1-4)
3. **Teachers** — the ability to \_\_\_\_\_ the Scriptures, \_\_\_\_\_ Biblical principles and \_\_\_\_\_ believers in the application of truth in their lives. (Rom. 12:6-7; 1 Cor. 12:28-29; Acts 13:1)
4. **Exhortation** — the gifted ability to \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ fellow believers in the character and Word of God. (Rom. 12:8)
5. **Administrations** — a gift to steer, \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ in the local church. (1Cor. 12:28)
6. **Ruling** — a gift to \_\_\_\_\_ the church in \_\_\_\_\_, priorities and doctrine. (1Thess. 5:12-13; 1Tim. 3:4-5, 12)
7. **Ministry** — a gift to \_\_\_\_\_ other believers in need. (Rom. 12:7; 1Cor. 12:28)
8. **Helps** — a gift to \_\_\_\_\_ the many \_\_\_\_\_ of other people in the local church and then the desire to meet those \_\_\_\_\_. (1Cor. 12:28)
9. **Giving** — a gift to give material \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ for the Lord's glory and others benefit. (Rom. 12:8)
10. **Mercy** — a gift to extend great \_\_\_\_\_, forbearance and \_\_\_\_\_ to others in their trials and suffering. (Rom. 12: 8)
