1.	By virtue of your position in Jesus Christ you have received "". (v. 3a)
	* According to v. 3, who is said to be the source of our blessing?
	* How is this distinctly different than the nation of Israel?
2.	At the very you were you received these blessings – "who has blessed us" (aorist/active/part.).
	* What does this say about those who pray for a "second blessing" from the Holy Spirit?
3.	The sphere of our blessings is "in the heavenlies" (v. 3b, cf. 1:20; 2:6; 3:10; 6:12)
4.	As a believer your whole life should be centered in heaven
	a. Your is in heaven. (Philip. 3:20)
	b. Your is in heaven. (Luke 10:20)
	c. Your ought to be on heavenly things. (Col. 3:1-4)

1.	When it comes to this word "chose" – it simply means that God to save those who to trust in His Son—thus the sovereignty of God and the freewill of man together. (v. 4a)
2.	Men and women are lost because they are not elected, no, they are lost and perishing because they have to Jesus Christ as their personal Savior (John 5:39-40; 1 Tim. 2:3-4; 2 Pet. 3:9)
3.	Two stated purposes for our election is that ideally "we (1) holy and (2) without blame before Him in love." (v. 4b)
4.	You become a part of God's family by (the new birth—John 3:1-18; 1 Peter 1:22-25); is where God gives you an adult status with all its privileges. (v. 5a)
5.	This "sonship" is possible because of Jesus Christ; and it demonstrates that it was always "the good pleasure of "to enjoy with us. (v. 5b)
6.	While we cannot possibly make ourselves acceptable, according to the riches of God's He has given us an eternal, privileged in His Son ("the Beloved"). (v. 6, cf. 1:7, 18; 2:4, 7; 3:8, 16)
