(James 3:13-16)

## II. IMPLEMENTING DIVINE WISDOM (3:13-18)

#### A. The Challenge to the Wise to Demonstrate His Wisdom (3:13)

1. The challenge by James for the believer who claims to be *"wise"* is that he should effectively demonstrate his *"understanding"* in his \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ which true wisdom produces (v. 13a)

2. The work that shows others that true \_\_\_\_\_\_ wisdom has been \_\_\_\_\_\_ is when things are done *"in meekness of wisdom"*. (v. 13b)

\* What does it mean to be meek? Does it mean you are to be a "doormat"?

#### **B.** The Evidence of False Wisdom in Control (3:14-16)

1. The antithesis of meekness is bitter \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_, they are certainly not the fruits of faith. (v. 14a)

To boast about wisdom when one is displaying jealousy and selfish ambition is, in effect, to bluntly \_\_\_\_\_\_ about the truth— that \_\_\_\_\_\_ must be associated with \_\_\_\_\_\_. (v. 14b)

  - b. "sensual" (Eph. 2:3), the \_\_\_\_\_
  - c. *"demonic"* (Eph. 2:2b), from \_\_\_\_\_

- 4. James pronounces his harsh verdict on human (pseudo) wisdom by describing the negative effects it produces (v. 16)...
  - a. It shows itself in "\_\_\_\_\_".
  - b. It shows itself in "\_\_\_\_\_ *thing*".

5. When confusion and evil reign in a local church—\_\_\_\_\_, factions, and \_\_\_\_\_, will inevitably break out to the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord. (Prov. 9:10; Gal. 5:15, 26)
