REACHING a Sinful Samaritan With the Evangel (4:1-26) a) Follow the leading of the Holy Spirit. (vv. 1-4) b) Go where the fish are biting! (vv. 1-4) c) Be willing to transcend social and cultural barriers. (vv. 4-9) d) Be willing to sacrificially extend yourself. (v. 6) e) Go where the fish are to do your fishing. (vv. 6-7) f) Initiate the conversation - Go fishing! (v. 7) g) Try to have a private conversation. (v. 8) h) Arouse interest by establishing common ground. (vv. 7-15)
  - i) Be willing to listen, as well as talk. (vv. 7-15)

j) Be very gracious, positive, and non-judgmental. (vv. 7-15)
k) Don't make a closing appeal or offer assurance until they comprehend the truth. (v. 15)
1) Do raise their awareness of personal sin. (vv. 16-18)
m) Aim for the heart, not just the intellect. (vv. 7-18)
n) Beware of rabbit-trails & keep the focus on the Lord. (vv. 19-20)
o) Gently present the truth but don't argue. (vv. 20-25)
p) Don't go too far too fast - be patient. (vv. 25-26)
q) Be prepared to give your personal testimony. (vv. 28-29, 39)
r) Be willing & available to let the Lord use even you! (vv. 28-29, 39)
2. TEACHING the Stubborn Disciples About Evangelism (4:27-42)
a) The disciples had failed to see beyond their own needs to the needs of the Samaritans. (vv27-35)
b) Evangelism is often a cooperative effort that involves both and (vv36-38)
c) Evangelism involves both sharing the Good News and personal with new believers. (vv39-42)
