#### B. The Significance of Christ's Burial as It Relates to the GOSPEL OF CHRIST (1 Cor. 15:3-4)

(Matt. 16:20-21; 17:22-23; 20:17-19; Mark 8:29-31; 9:30-32; 10:32-34; Luke 18:31-34; 24:7, 26, 46; Acts 2:23-24; 3:15; 4:10; 5:30; 10:39-40; 17:3; 25:19; 26:23; Rom. 4:24-25; 5:9-10; 8:34; Gal. 1:1-4; 1 Thess. 4:14; 1 Peter 1:2-3, 11, 18-21; 3:18-21)
- c) . . . our eternal \_\_\_\_\_\_ does not rest upon Christ's burial and postresurrection appearances but upon His \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. (Rom. 4:25; 1 Cor. 15:17-18).
- d) . . . there are no other \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ that specifically require belief in Christ's burial and post-resurrection appearances to be saved, as there are with Christ's person and work. (Rom. 10:9; 1 Cor. 1:18; 2:2; 1 Thess. 4:14)
- e) . . . the burial and appearances of Christ are not \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to Christ's person as are His deity (John 8:24), humanity (1 Tim. 2:4-5), sacrificial death (John 6:53), and resurrection (Rev. 5:6).
