### D. THE SIGN OF JONAH (Luke 11:29-32)

- 1. Because He knew their \_\_\_\_\_\_ hearts, Jesus responded to His critic's request for a sign that He was the Messiah with an emphatic \_\_\_\_\_\_! (v. 29a)
- 2. A *"sign"* was a confirming \_\_\_\_\_\_ which showed that the spoken message was true; it is clear that the crowds were \_\_\_\_\_\_ to believe Jesus' words without external confirmation. (v. 29b)
- 3. The "sign of Jonah the prophet" can be viewed two ways...
  - a. <u>Luke's emphasis</u>: Even the Gentiles of Nineveh \_\_\_\_\_\_ Jonah's preaching of judgment and \_\_\_\_\_\_ without any miracles. (Luke 11:29b-30)
  - b. <u>Matthew's emphasis</u>: Just as Jonah was three \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be in the heart of the earth. (Matt. 12:38-41)
- 4. The Gentile Queen of Sheba traveled a long distance to hear the wisdom of a great king in Israel, yet Jesus' generation had the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ in their very presence and they volitionally \_\_\_\_\_\_ His words. (v. 31)

#### E. THE IMPORTANCE OF RESPONDING TO THE LIGHT (Luke 11:33-36)

1. Verse 33 is a rebuke to the \_\_\_\_\_\_ Jews, who had the light but would \_\_\_\_\_\_ use it; whereas Christ preached the "light" to the world. (v. 33)

\* How could this also be a warning to His disciples?
