## F. JESUS EXPOSES THE SINS OF THE PHARISEES AND THE SCRIBES (Luke 11:37-54)

- 1. The Pharisee's motives seem \_\_\_\_\_\_ at best, had he been sincere in seeking out truth, he would have most likely wanted a \_\_\_\_\_\_ conversation so as to not be seen publicly with Jesus. (v. 37)
- 2. Jesus offended His host by completely \_\_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_
- Christ responded by exposing the religious leader's hypocrisy who were present; they foolishly thought that righteousness was based on external \_\_\_\_\_\_ rather than internal \_\_\_\_\_\_. (v. 39-40)
- 4. Verse 41 could be translated more literally, "*But rather give the things that are inside,*" that is, give first the offering of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ man, give from your \_\_\_\_\_\_. (v. 41)
- 5. Jesus addressed the Pharisees with three harsh, stinging "Woes" of condemnation...
  - a. In being meticulous about the external observances of the Law, the Pharisees completely \_\_\_\_\_\_ doing what was right out of agape \_\_\_\_\_\_ for the Lord and other people. (v. 42)

- c. Unmarked graves when walked on, would defile a Jew without even knowing it (Num. 19:16); likewise, the nation was \_\_\_\_\_\_ being spiritually \_\_\_\_\_\_ by the Pharisees. (v. 44)
- 6. The lawyers wanted Jesus to make a distinction between them and the Pharisees (v. 45), but our Lord responded by giving them three exhorting *"Woes"* of rebuke of their own...
  - a. Jesus condemned the legal experts who were good at adding additional religious
     \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to an already overburdened people; but yet they were \_\_\_\_\_\_\_
     willing to personally help the people. (v. 46)
  - b. Outwardly the lawyers seemed to honor the prophets by building monuments over their graves, but Jesus knew that \_\_\_\_\_\_ they were \_\_\_\_\_\_ the prophets. (vv. 47-51)
  - c. The people viewed the scribes as having the "key" to understanding the Scriptures, but because they \_\_\_\_\_\_ the Messiah's teaching they thereby \_\_\_\_\_\_
