

## “ARE YOU FAITHFUL WITH WHAT YOU HAVE BEEN GIVEN?”

(Luke 19:11-27)

### A. JESUS BRINGS SALVATION TO A MAN NAMED ZACCHAEUS (Luke 19:1-10)

### B. THE PARABLE OF THE TEN MINAS (Luke 19:11-27)

1. Many of Jesus' followers believed that He was still going to \_\_\_\_\_ His kingdom when He arrived in Jerusalem, and so He wanted to remind them once again it would be \_\_\_\_\_. (v. 11)
  
2. The “*nobleman*” in the parable obviously represents Jesus who went to His Father to receive the kingdom from Him, and Christ would then \_\_\_\_\_ to earth to \_\_\_\_\_ as King. (v. 12)
