I. SURVEY OF THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

A. JESUS CAME WITH A PURPOSE

1. The opening words, “*those things which have been fulfilled among us*” reveal that Luke’s purpose for writing centers around God’s _____ fulfilled in the Person and work of His Son. (1:1, 4)
2. The announcement of all announcements! “*For there is born to you this day in the city of David a _____ who is _____ the _____.*” (2:11)
3. One of Luke’s main themes is the _____ scope of salvation, and here he intentionally stated that God would make salvation available to _____ people groups. (Luke 2:30-32; Ps. 98:3; Isa. 40:1-5; 42:6; 49:6; 52:10; Acts 28:28)
4. 19:10 is the _____ to the Gospel of Luke, and the primary _____ Jesus came to earth, “*to seek and to save that which was lost.*” (cf. 1 John 3:8; Ezek. 33:11)

B. JESUS REPEATEDLY DEMONSTRATED HIS MESSIANIC CREDENTIALS

1. On several occasions Christ’s authority over _____ was apparent, like when He healed the paralytic (5:17-26) or forgave the woman who anointed His feet (7:36-50).
2. A couple of examples of His power over _____ was when He filled the disciples’ nets (5:1-11) quieted the storm, (8:22-25) and fed the 5,000 (9:12-17).
3. His sovereign power over _____ was evident on many occasions when they bowed down and acknowledged that He was the SON of the Most High. (4:33-37; 41; 8:26-39; 9:37-43)
4. There are countless examples of Christ’s power over _____. (4:38-40; 5:12-14; 7:1-10; 8:42-48; 17:11-19; 18:35-43; 22:50-51)

5. His power over _____ was on display several times (7:11-18; 8:41-56), but never more pronounced than in the raising of Himself in His own resurrection. (John 2:19-22)
6. Christ expressed His divine _____ in the statement that He was “*Lord of the Sabbath*”; He knew best on how to interpret the Law of Moses because He _____ it! (6:5-11; 13:10-17; 14:1-6)
