## THE PRIORITY OF HEARING THE WORD OF GOD

(Nehemiah 8:1-8)

## I. EZRA THE PRIEST LEADS THE PEOPLE IN CORPORATE BIBLE STUDY (8:1-8)

## A. The People had a YEARNING to HEAR the Word of God (8:1-6)
