	1.	Nehemiah had been diligently working behind the scenes in making preparations; he enlisted and from all over Judah to guarantee that the
		dedication service would be nothing less than spectacular. (vv. 27-29)
	2.	Everyone took this dedication of the walls very, there was a ceremonial of the people before it began. (v. 30)
	3.	Nehemiah assembled two great choirs to sing, play instruments and give thanks to the Lord a led one group on the southern and eastern wall counter clockwise. (vv. 31-37)
		b led a second group clockwise on the northern wall. (vv. 38-39)
		c. Both choirs of thanksgiving met at the, and they sang together so "that the joy of Jerusalem was heard afar off." (vv. 40-43)
	4.	The emphasis: It was on <i>joyful praise</i> on the part of all the people; is mentioned 8x in this chapter, 6x, 7x, and musical instruments 3x.
	5.	The people brought their and, not only because it was the commandment of God, but also because they "rejoiced over the priest and Levites who ministered." (vv. 44-47)
