



## 2. God's TRUTH Revealed (vv. 19-20)

- a. The Lord God has made Himself known through the internal \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of every human being. (v. 19a, cf. Rom. 2:14-16; Ps. 14:1-3)
- b. The emphasis in v. 19 is on the preposition- the universal objective \_\_\_\_\_ of God as the \_\_\_\_\_ "*is manifest* \_\_\_\_\_ *them.*" (v. 19b)
- c. In every generation "*since the creation of the world*" God has revealed through general revelation, through His \_\_\_\_\_ the fact that there is an infinitely Supreme Being to whom we are \_\_\_\_\_. (v. 20a, cf. Psalm 8:3-9; 19:1; 90:2; 136:3-9; Ecc. 12:1; John 1:1-3; Col. 1:16-17)

\* Is this general revelation of conscience and creation limited in telling us the deeper things of God?

\* What is needed to give us specific, personal knowledge of a loving Creator?

- d. God is an infinite Being, which means that He cannot be fully comprehended by finite beings; but God has \_\_\_\_\_ condescended, and made Himself \_\_\_\_\_ to those who humbly \_\_\_\_\_ to His drawing.
- e. Because God has revealed His "*eternal* \_\_\_\_\_ *and* \_\_\_\_\_," those people who \_\_\_\_\_ to acknowledge Him or trust Him "*are without excuse*" (Gk. *anapologetos*), i.e., they are ripe for judgment. (v. 20b)
