a.	OBJECTIONS to God's Sovereign Choice of Israel
	1) Objection #1 - God's unconditional, sovereign choice of Israel was, it was even (v. 14)
	Illustration #1 When the Israelites had sinned at the foot of Mt. Sinai with the golden calf idol worship (Ex. 32:10, 33:19), all of them deserved God's, but instead they received His (v. 15)
	<i>Principle</i> - Neither man's nor his can determine <i>how</i> the Lord should bestow divine blessings and mercy; men and women will be able to boast that they influenced God's sovereign plans. (vv. 16, 18)
	Illustration #2 When the Egyptian Pharaoh refused to obey God (Ex. 5-14), he deserved God's, and he received God's (v. 17)
	2) Objection #2- How can God man if man has no but to do God's will? (v. 19)
b.	ANSWERS to those Objections Regarding God's Sovereign Choice
	1) Answer #1- God has the inherent right as the to make someone a vessel unto honor or common use, whether they positively or negatively to His saving grace. (vv. 20-21, cf. Is. 29:16-17; 45:9; Jer. 18:1-12)

2)	Answer #2- The objection raised back in v. 19 actually reveals man's
_,	toward God and His toward stubborn man. (v. 22)
	* How do we know that the words "prepared for destruction" are NOT teaching reprobation?
3)	Answer #3- God is perfectly in His sovereign choice to now include believing in this Church-age to be His vessels unto glory, just as He originally chose national Israel in the past. (vv. 23-24)
