## VII.GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS REVEALED THRU THE CHURCH (12:1-16:23)

## A. SPIRITUAL GIFTS AND THE LOCAL CHURCH

- 1. The spiritual gifting by the Holy Spirit is that which \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ the local church. (I Cor. 12:7; 14:5, 26)

## **B. SPECIFIC GIFTS TO THE CHURCH**

  - a. *"prophecy"* is the God-given ability to \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ divine revelation. (v. 6d)
  - b. *"ministry"* is the special ability to \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ others when the need arises. (v. 7a)
