## VII. GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS REVEALED THRU THE CHURCH (12:1-16:23)

Α.	Th	e Christian's Responsibility to Our Governing Authorities (13:1-2)
	1.	This happens to be the longest passage in the New Testament about to the governing authorities, and the verb "be subject" (Gk. hupotasso) is the verb to the whole passage. (v. 1)
	2.	The reason that these governing authorities even in the first place, is because God has not only them (v. 1b), but He also them (v. 2).
В.	Th	ne Role that Government Plays in the Life of the Believer (13:3-4)
	1.	Human government exists for the purpose of the and the (v. 3)
	2.	As Bible-believing Christians, and law-abiding citizens, we ought to view our government as a "" thing, even as God's "". (v. 4a)
	3.	If one chooses to commit capital crimes, the government has the authority from God to use the "" (Gk. <i>manchaira</i> ), which is a reference to (v. 4b)
		* Isn't this optional for each individual government? (Gen. 9:6)

	4.	Some might claim that this is inconsistent with the sixth commandment; but Scripturally there are three justifiable reasons for taking another person's life.
		a defense (Ex. 22:2-3; Esther 9; Luke 22:36)
		b defense (Deut. 20:10-12; Neh. 4:17-18)
		c punishment (Gen. 9:5-6; Lev. 24:21; Luke 23:40-41; Acts 25:11, 25)
		* Isn't all of this inconsistent with being Pro-life?
C.		ne Responsibilities of the Believer towards God's Established Government (5-7)
	1.	The Christian is to be (Gk. hupotasso) to the civil authorities not only to avoid punishment, but also for one's own sake before the Lord (v. 5, cf 1 Pet. 2:13-15).
	2.	Jesus said, "Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." (Matt. 22:21); likewise, Paul is teaching that God wants believers to the government by (v. 6)
		* But what if the taxes are also used to support things that are unscriptural?
	3.	The Lord also desires that Christians would show and towards those in government. (v. 7)
		* Are you willing to make application with this passage in your own life?
