\* Why do we need this armor? (Eph. 6:10-18)

  - a. "knowing" (Rom. 6:3, 6, 9)
  - b. *"reckoning"* (Rom. 6:11)
  - c. "yielding" (Rom. 6:12-13, 16, 19)
  - \* You can begin applying this truth today.
