### I. ARE YOU PERSONALLY AWARE OF THE PROBLEM OF PRIDE?

#### A. WHAT is PRIDE?

### B. Humility involves GRACE-ORIENTATION

2. You must understand and \_\_\_\_\_ the Gospel of Jesus Christ in order to be saved. (Matt. 18:3-4; 21:28-32; Rom. 5:6-8; 1 Cor. 1:17-30)
3. You must learn to give all the \_\_\_\_\_ to the \_\_\_\_\_. (1 Cor. 1:31; 15:10)
4. You must allow God's Word (via the Holy Spirit) to \_\_\_\_\_ you as a believer the riches of God's \_\_\_\_\_. (1 Cor. 2:12; 4:7; 8:1-2; 2 Pet. 3:18)
