

## “EVANGELISM: WHAT IS IT AND HOW IS IT DONE?”

### A. The MEANING of Effective Evangelism

1. GREEK— “*euangelion*” (noun)
  - a. This Greek word’s basic meaning is that of \_\_\_\_\_.

2. GREEK “*euangelizo*” (verb)

### B. The MESSAGE of Effective Evangelism

### C. The MANDATE for Effective Evangelism
