	a.	Not only was Yahweh David's, turning his darkness into light, but God also gave him the supernatural ability to the obstacles of life. (vv 29-30)		
	b.	David had discovered that the true source of and for the spiritual life of faith was found in the Lord God and His Word. (vv. 31-33)		
	c.	David utilized several poetic metaphors to acknowledge that Jehovah had taken an otherwise life and made it absolutely; God had given him the ability to triumph over his enemies. (vv. 34-43)		
4.		Yahweh delivered David not only from foreign powers but also from domestic opposition, perhaps members and or fellow (v. 44a)		
	b.	So successful were David's military campaigns that foreigners he didn't even know subjugated themselves to him he could even mount an against them. (vv. 44b-46)		
	c.	In closing David not only announced the most profound truth, "the Lord!" but he also stated that God was the Rock of his personal! (v. 47)
