- a. Seek no other sense . . . The writers were trying to communicate!
  - i. Plain sense What is the most \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_ meaning? (John 21:11)
  - ii. Common sense Is Christ commanding cannibalism? (John 6:54)
  - iii. Primary, ordinary, usual, literal meaning "whole world"? (1 John 2:2)
- b. Unless the facts of the immediate context, studied in the light of related passages and axiomatic and fundamental truths, indicate clearly otherwise.
  - i. Context Malachi 3:10 If I tithe 10%, will God make me rich?
  - Studied in the light of related passages James 2:24 vs Romans 4:1-7 Is a person saved because of faith or works?
  - iii. Axiomatic and fundamental truths Is Christ a door or a stone?
