A. JESUS WARNS ABOUT POTENTIAL SPIRITUAL DIVISION (Luke 12:49-59)

1.	John 3:17 informs us that Jesus did not come into the world to judge it (this referred to His 1 ST Advent); but at His He is bringing a whole lot of and (v. 49; cf., 2 Pet. 3:10-13; Rev. 19:11-21)
2.	Before Jesus' judging ministry would begin, would be in a horrible baptism of blood, agony, and death for the sins of the world. (v. 50a, cf., Mark 10:32-40)
3.	Just the very thought of becoming the object of His and the spiritual death that would follow, caused our Lord to be distressed regarding His mission. (v. 50b, cf., John 12:27-28)
4.	From the very beginning of Jesus' ministry there was by the religious leaders who influenced other's personal beliefs in Him. (v. 51)
5.	Differences of opinion on what individual family members concerning the Christ would cause great in those families for the next 2,000 years. (v. 52)
6.	There is a going on in every home, between what the Word of God has to say and what the flesh, the world, and the devil have to say. (v. 53, cf. Eph. 6:10-17)

	* Are you willing to take a stand in defense of Christ and the gospel or do you think your family member's souls are really not worth the fight?
7.	In light of the coming judgment, Jesus turned to the and used two illustrations to hammer home this truth
	a. Your average farmer wouldn't have any difficulty in predicting as he observed the clouds approaching nor would he have trouble in determining the wind was going to be if it came from the south. (vv. 54-55)
	b. The Jews in Jesus' day had to notice the sign of the times, they hadn't noticed a plethora of being fulfilled by the Messiah right before their very own eyes. (vv. 56-57)
	* Are you listening? Have you forgotten the Lord's return is imminent?
8.	Using another earthly illustration Jesus said that as you are being forcibly dragged into court, make "" along the way before it is too late, because is just around the corner. (v. 58)
9.	It is sobering to think about the destinies of the lost; their and tortures in the Lake of Fire are eternally (v. 59)
